#### Dr. Daniel S. German, D.D.S.

*“Hygienist Orthodontic Heaven” No Braces, No Plaque, No Gingivitis, No Decay, No Decalcification...Let's Talk Invisalign, Using 3-D Cone Beam Diagnostics.*

Dr. Dan will be speaking on Invisalign, Invisalign Teen and 3-D Cone Beam Imaging. German Burke Orthodontics has been named an Elite Invisalign practice, a designation Invisalign awards to less than one percent of Invisalign Certified Doctors. Dr. Dan has been serving the Dayton community since 1987. He completed his undergraduate and dental school education at Case Western Reserve University followed by orthodontic residency at The University of Louisville. Dr. Dan has been the keynote speaker, teaching German Burke Orthodontic's innovative orthodontic therapy at many Orthodontic Association meetings ranging from Alaska to South Africa.
