“Periodontal & Remineralization Protocols: Fast Tracking Clinical Success”

As a frequent contributor to national publications, she has served on numerous editorial boards, most recently as the Hygiene Editor for www.Dentalcompare.com and has a chapter on Oral Malodor in the latest edition of Mosby's Dental Hygiene textbook. Course Description: This fast paced and interactive session will overview accelerated instrumentation protocols also known as full-mouth disinfection. Researchers continue to explore fast tracking quadrant scaling and root planning phases from six weeks to days and most adjunctive research also includes this type of approach. Participants will evaluate their current treatment modalities and establish plans for implementing accelerated instrumentation. In addition, modifications for the protocol will be discussed including pain control options, use of locally applied antimicrobials, tongue disinfection, and daily care products options. In addition, participants will also be introduced to the latest advancement remineralization strategies, including fluoride, calcium and phosphate delivery systems. A review of science will include the desensitizing action as well as the research reporting remineralization among other clinical benefits. Additional topics will include a review of calcium phosphate technologies, their differences and products they are found in and how they work with fluoride. Is calcium phosphate the next "fluoride"? Replace 'burn out' with success through these strategic processes of care!
